

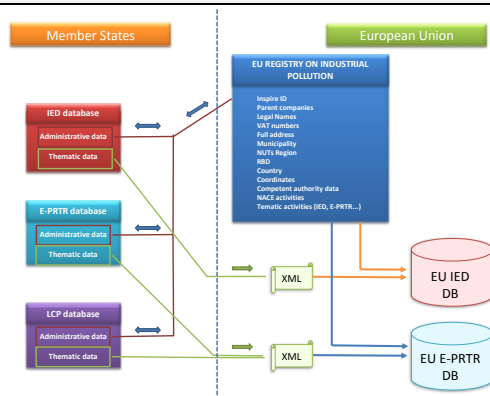

Detailed description of project

Type and scope of services provided



The aim of this project is to assist EU member states in the reporting of their industrial emissions. Reporting will be carried out using a flexible and user friendly Electronic Reporting Tool covering both EU and national data needs and by integrating the latest requirements arising from relevant EU Directives (EPRTR, IED LCP & INSPIRE). The general concept is to provide a central EU Registry which all the reports (E-PRTR, IED, LCP) coming from Member States will be based on.

The project will produce the following tangible results:

- Technical Specification document detailing the operation of the individual tools and including mock-ups of the different elements,
- A complete software release of the Electronic Reporting Tool for IED deployed in the EEA's operational environment (remote server of a hosting provider) which will include:
 - o Updated source code, fully commented,
 - o Installation package and patches &
 - o Release notes outlining the changes from previous releases.
- Updated technical and user documentation including user manual and handover documentation.

Main objectives of the project are:

- Detailed Work Plan fine-tuning of all details for undertaking projects's tasks,
- The design implementation and testing of the various software components that will comprise the Electronic Reporting Tool and their initial integration into a first functional prototype,
- Informative Sessions with Reporting Countries -IED Expert Group,
- Compilation of Documentation, Standards and User Manual,
- Deployment, testing with Member States, bug fixing and support,
- Hosting/maintenance of the 'Electronic Reporting Tool'
- Processing of the reported data, finalisation of the database, final bug-fixing, and handover of the 'Electronic Reporting.
