		<p>The irrigation scheme has an area of 11.450 acres (1.145 ha) and is located at the north-west part of Peloponnisos, Prefect of Messinia, Jurisdiction of Pilia, and at a distance of 45 km from Kalamata. The establishment of the irrigation scheme will have positive impacts on the area in absolute terms, however, an indication exists on competitive land-use development contrasted to the residential uses for example. This issue of competition has to be analyzed in the future, given also the reluctance of the population to have the scheme established. <p>Lake eutrophication is expected if not appropriate fertilization practices are not established. During the preliminary phase of the analysis no adverse impacts have been identified on the fauna of the region, the fish population and the livestock development. The wetlands of the area and the lake of Yalova can be managed to become an important biotope of the region.</p>
