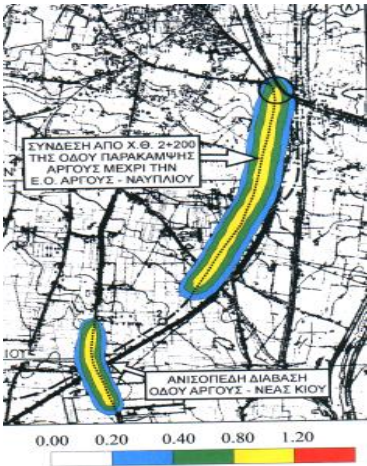

 - Construction of Argos Bypass termination road section, 900m long, in order to render functional the existing, 2300m long, Argos bypass. The road section terminates in Argos – Nafplio motorway. - Construction of the two-level junction of Argos – N. Kios road, 600m long, aiming to the safer and faster vehicle transportation. Environmental impacts - Tourist development of N. Kios. - Noise pollution and dust deriving from works and vehicle transportation during construction. - Increase of vehicle circulation and improvement of transportation conditions. - Change of landscape and aesthetic upgrading. - Vegetation depilation and fauna annoyance. Mitigation measures - Monitoring of noise emissions every five years. - Planting of slopes and embankments. - Collection and disposal of excavation material and recovery of sediment extraction sites. - Monitoring of soil erosion. - Provide wet conditions to bare soils and cover unused materials.
