Description of the project

Description

EPSILON participated in a tender for consultancy services to conduct a risk assessment at the Port of Valletta Passenger Terminal. The project included the analysis of potential risks and hazards at the Valletta and Senglea passenger terminals, development of recommendations based on identified scenarios, and the preparation of a mass evacuation plan.



The assessment focused on cruise and ferry passenger operations and considered port access, vessel operations, onshore and offshore hazards, and health and

safety risks during disembarkation. The work involved expert consultation, hazard identification, consequence assessment, and the development of risk mitigation and evacuation procedures. EPSILON contributed key experts in risk assessment, civil protection and maritime safety.

- Completed analysis of potential risks at Valletta and Senglea terminals
- Recommendations on identified risk scenarios
- Development of a mass evacuation plan for cruise ships and terminal
- Presentation of findings in a tabletop exercise involving stakeholders
